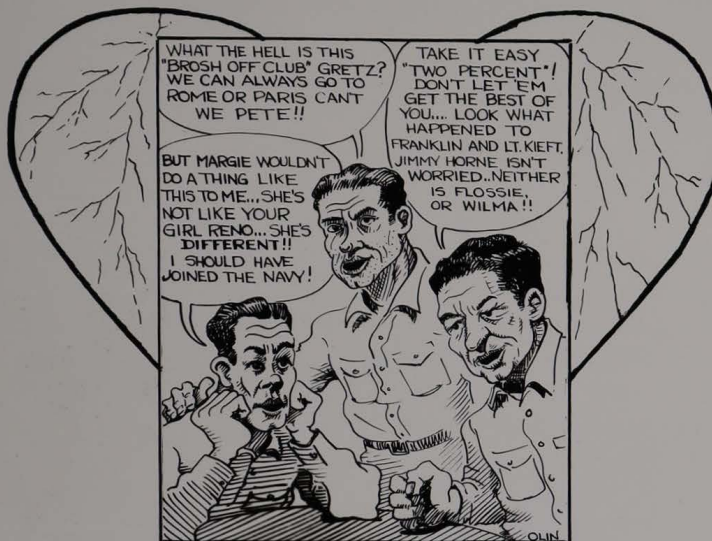
### THE ALPHA
